

Unknown Eritrean Refugees Corpses in Egyptian Hospitals

Radio Voice of Eritrea, a news agency based in Australia, reported that Egyptian hospitals are keeping eight unknown Eritrean refugees corpses in their mortuary. The corpses have been kept in different hospitals for over a month now of which 2 were recently released and flown to Eritrea at the cost of \$2,600 US dollars for each, added Radio Voice of Eritrea. The remaining 6 corpses won't be released as the cost of transportation and airfare expenses to Eritrea cannot be made available.

In related news, Egyptian authorities are still keeping a large number of Eritrean refugees in various detention facilities in which some of the refugees have already stayed over a year in those detention centers. According to Radio Voice of Eritrea, Egyptian authorities have made a decision to keep the refugees imprisoned until the refugees pay their own travel expenses back to Eritrea.
